

Want to travel to Western Australia for research purposes?


JH Lord Travel Grants are available to support your attendance at geological conferences and field excursions in Western Australia.

Applications are only available to:

- postgraduate students and new postdoctoral researchers
- those presenting the results of their work at a conference held in Western Australia.

Grants will typically cover the registration fee and subsidise an economy airfare to Western Australia and budget accommodation costs.

For applicants from developing countries (as defined by the United Nations Development Programme), the Travel Grants Committee has the discretion to make travel and accommodation arrangements associated with the conference and fully cover these costs. The recipients of such grants will be encouraged to visit local research institutions to promote scientific exchange.
